We hope you have been enjoying the lovely weather that we have been blessed with recently. We encourage you to go outside to enjoy the fresh air and warm sunshine.

We are pleased to announce a couple of changes happening at Lindenwood Manor and Lindenwood Terrace.

Visitors

In the last memo we had asked you to choose two essential visitors who could come into your suite. We are now opening this up, so you do not have to limit it to two people. We request that the following guidelines are followed:

1. All guests must put on a mask before entering the building, wash/sanitize their hands after entering the building and stop by the front desk to answer our screening questions. If they do not pass the screening questions, they will be asked to leave.
2. During in-suite visits physical/social distancing must always be maintained and masks should be worn by your guests.
3. We ask that a **maximum of three (3) guests** are in your suite at one time. We believe it will allow you to maintain physical/social distancing. If you wish to visit with more than three people at one time, please go outside to visit and ensure you remain 2 meters or 6 feet apart.
4. All indoor visits should be done in your suite. Visitors are not allowed in common areas such as sunrooms, hallways or laundry rooms.
5. All guests who have been out of province in the last two weeks will be denied entry. You are more than welcome to visit with such guests outdoors if physical/social distancing is maintained.

Suite to Suite Visits

We encourage residents to continue visiting in common areas, however, if you wish to invite fellow residents to your suite please ensure that physical/social distancing is maintained.
