DINING ROOM OPENING ON WEEKENDS

We are happy to announce that the dining room will be opening on Saturdays and Sundays ensuring meals in the dining room 7 days a week. Please see the attached calendar to find out when it is your turn to eat your meals in the dining room. The weekend sittings will start on Saturday April 24th.

VISITING OTHER RESIDENTS IN SUITES

We would like to remind you that, as per public health orders, only your two designated visitors are allowed in your suite. If you wish to visit with other residents, please do so in a common area safely.

MASKS AND SOCIAL DISTANCING

We (residents, staff and visitors) must continue to follow health guidelines by wearing masks in common areas of the building and physically/socially distancing. Please put on your mask when you leave your suite and keep at least 6 feet between yourself and others.

MOBILE HAIRDRESSERS

We contacted Dr. Rousin's office and found out that since hairstylists provide personal care services, you may now have a hairdresser come to your suite. This is effective immediately. Please ensure that both you and your hairdresser are wearing masks during the process.

We would like to stress that the items discussed in this memo are based on the current health orders. Because Manitoba Health can put in further restrictions at any time, changes may have to be made quickly in our building. We will always communicate changes with you via memos.
